

Installation & Setup Guide

Paycryptohost — accept Bitcoin, USDT, ETH, BNB, LTC, SOL, XMR

To start receiving payments, add cryptocurrency addresses to your Paycryptohost account. Follow the steps below.

Supported coins: BTC, USDT (TRC20), ETH (ERC-20), BNB (BEP-20), LTC, SOL, XMR.

1. Sign in to Paycryptohost

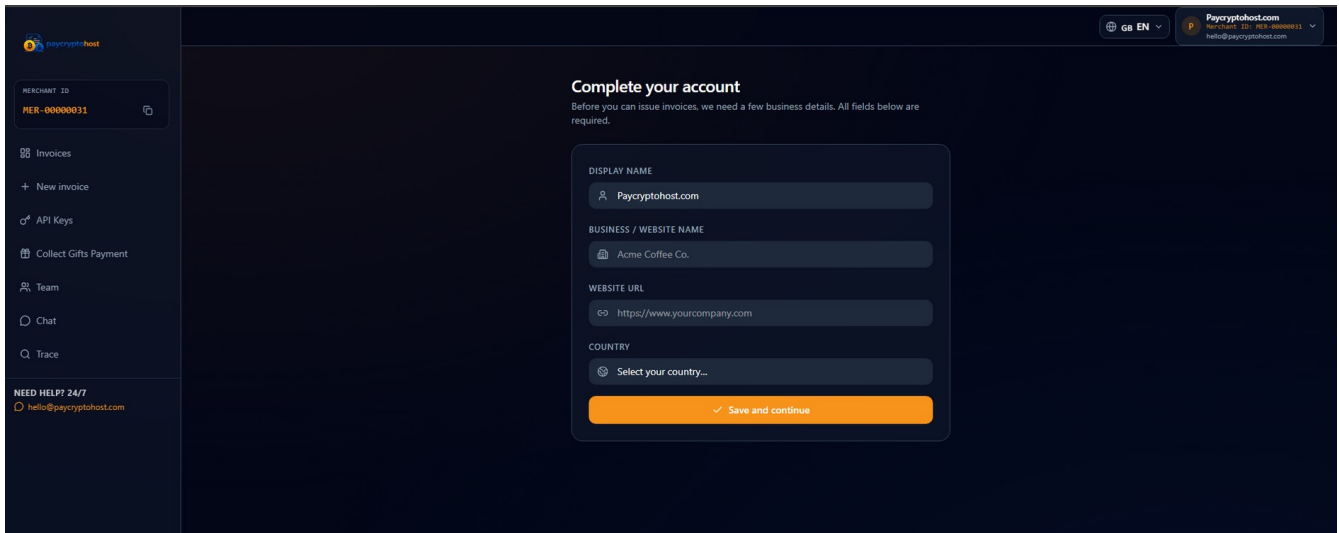

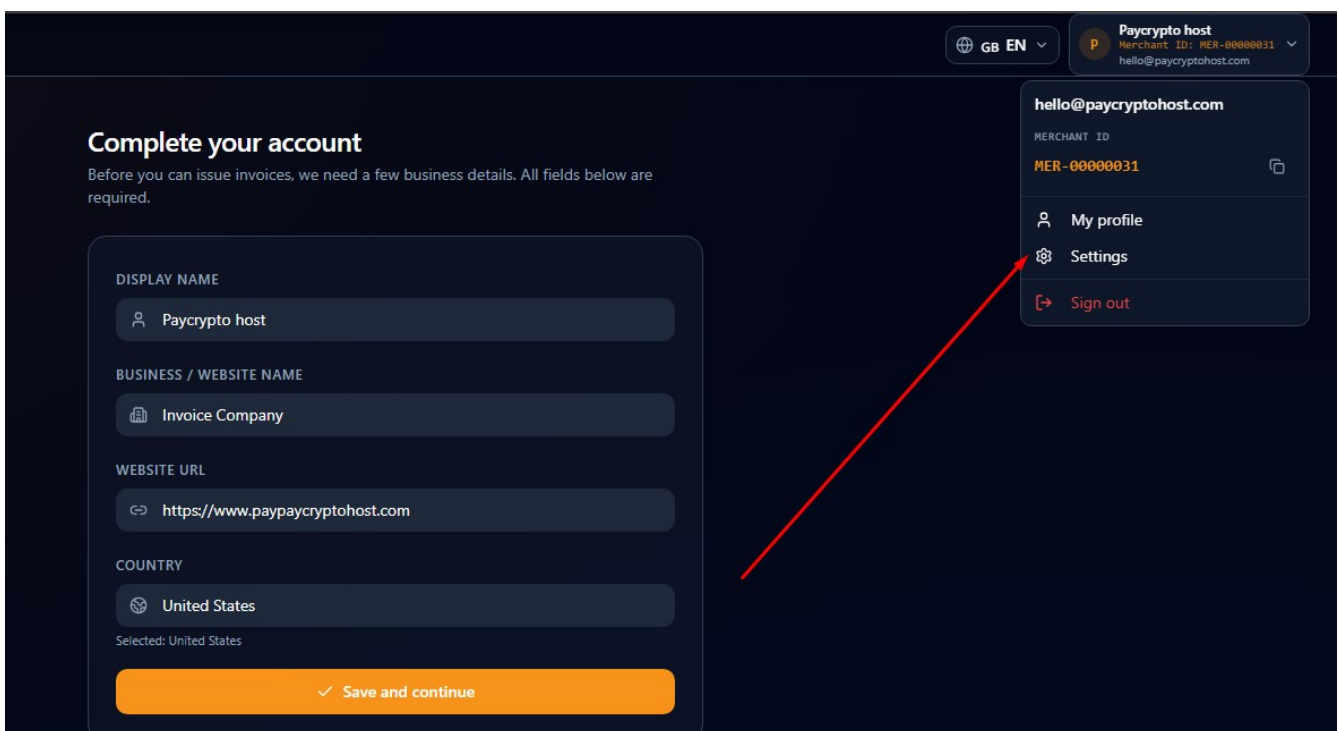
1. Sign in to Paycryptohost.

2. Open Settings & add branding

From your dashboard, open Settings in the top-right corner. Add your company logo, company name, and configure the coins you want to accept. Your logo and details automatically appear on every invoice you send.



2a. Dashboard — open Settings from the top-right.



2b. Settings — company details & coin configuration.

3. Coin Setup — choose one

In the Coin Setup section, choose Single Coin Address or xPub Wallet setup.

Option A — Single Wallet Address:

Works with most exchanges/wallets (Coinbase, Binance, Noones, LocalCoinSwap, Bisq, CoinFlip, Blockchain.com). Copy the receive address in your wallet and paste it into the matching coin in Paycrypto host.

Option B — xPub Wallet (recommended):

Generates a unique receiving address for every invoice — better privacy and tracking. Compatible with Electrum, Sparrow, Ledger, Blockchain.com, BlueWallet. In Electrum: Wallet -> Information. Copy the Master Public Key into the xPub field, and the first receiving address into the first-address field.

Funds settle in your own wallet.



Single Bitcoin address

 Active

All payments go to one address you control.
Simplest setup.

Mutually exclusive. Activating xPub disables the single address. Saving a single address disables xPub.
Only one mode receives payments at any time.

xPub (recommended)
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Single Bitcoin address Active
 All payments go to one address you control.
 Simplest setup.

Mutually exclusive. Activating xPub disables the single address. Saving a single address disables xPub. Only one mode receives payments at any time.

⚠ Recovery & safety. The xPub only lets us derive *receive* addresses — it cannot spend funds. Spending requires the wallet/seed you generated the xPub from. **Back up that wallet's recovery phrase now;** losing it means losing access to funds sent to derived addresses. If you lose just the xPub but still have the wallet, re-export it and replace it here.

First receiving address (proof of ownership)

bc1qexamplebtaddress1234567890educationonly

We derive the first 20 addresses from your xPub and require one to match. This proves the xPub is really yours before any payment is routed to it.

Wallet provider *

Electrum (electrum.org) — Most recommended

Pick the wallet that produced this xPub — you'll need its seed phrase to spend funds. Electrum is our top pick for reliability. Electrum can export XPUB, YPUB or ZPUB — paste whichever your account uses.

3b. Option B — xPub / master public key setup (recommended).

4. Verify & Activate

Click Verify and Activate. If everything checks out, your wallet is saved and activated automatically — you can start accepting payments right away.
